Community Notice – Upcoming Geomechanical Drilling North Virginiatown

Cadillac Mines Corporation wishes to inform residents of McGarry Township that geomechanical diamond drilling is planned for August 2026 at a single location in North Virginiatown, east of the Community Centre off 27th Avenue. The site is shown on the attached map.

We recognize that this work will take place close to residents, and we are committed to keeping you informed, minimizing disruption, and addressing any concerns directly.

Timeline and Operations

Drilling is expected to begin in early August and continue for approximately three weeks. One drill rig will operate at the site during this period. Operations will run 24 hours per day, 7 days per week during active drilling. The work will include a diamond drill rig and support vehicles for personnel and material transport.

What to Expect

- One drill site at the location shown on the attached map
- Sound walls surrounding the drill to reduce noise and provide a secure perimeter
- Support vehicle traffic during mobilization and active operations

Purpose of the Work

Geomechanical drilling collects information on rock strength and ground conditions. This data supports engineering design and study requirements.

Safety and Environment

Cadillac Mines and its contractors maintain established operational standards:

- Sound walls and noise mitigation around the active drill site
- Clearly marked safety perimeters and signage
- Spill prevention systems at all fuel and fluid storage locations
- Progressive site restoration upon completion

All work is conducted on Cadillac Mines surface and mining rights in compliance with Ontario's Mining Act, Occupational Health and Safety Act, and applicable environmental regulations
